
### ABOUT ISDA PROJECT



The ISDA project in Rwanda focuses on overcoming corruption-related barriers to improve access to education and healthcare services for vulnerable groups.

Under the ISDA project, TI-Rwanda conducted research and other engagements aimed at assessing the corruption vulnerabilities in the delivery of healthcare and education in Rwanda, as well as to look at how corruption may prevent women, girls, and other vulnerable groups from their right to access healthcare and education services.


